



Agapanthus orientalis 'PMN06' PPAF - A new Agapanthus from "Down Unda" with extra large umbels, each with close to 150 bicolored flowers! Does it make a statement in the landscape? You bet. Like most A. orientalis varieties, Queen Mum is a big plant so it is great for large estates and commercial landscapes but can also be used in large containers or as a specimen in patio gardens. Disease tolerant, frost tolerant, drought tolerant, low maintenance, great flower...what else can we say!



CROP TIME:

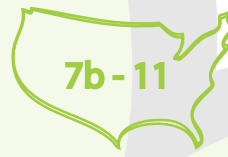
1-gal: 8-12 mos. from liners
3's & up: 12-24 mos. from liners

*depending on inputs & climate



SALES STRATEGY:

For retail, sell in bloom or prebloom; spring and summer. For the landscape market, this plant will sell almost year round.



LANDSCAPE NICHE:

In full sun, Queen Mum is great for mass, border or accent plantings and will offer a nice summer bloom with little care.



CONTAINER APP:

Use in large planters like those in commercial settings and urban street-scaping. AND, it is also great as a cut flower!!



Leaf:

- Broad, straplike foliage with a fleshy texture and bright green & glossy finish; typical of A. orientalis



Habit:

- Rhizomatous perennial that can reach 3 ft. H (5 ft in flower) by 3+ ft. W; dense foliage with an arched habit
- Zones 7b -11 for landscape applications



Apps:

- Low Maintenance & Drought Tolerant
- Great for borders, mass planting or as an accent
- Home Gardens
- Streetscapes & Commercial Landscapes



Bloom:

- Umbels borne on tall, robust peduncles of approx 3-3.5 ft. tall, each umbel is loaded with close to 150 blue/white bicolor flowers. Blooms in summer. Color is best in full sun.

Notables:

- LIKES - Well drained soils and full sun
- DISLIKES - Heavy shade, wet feet & relentless winters.

Sales Niche:

- A low-maintenance container or landscape perennial with a beautiful flower display in summer. Perfect for milder climates.
