



**Callistemon viminalis 'CV01' PPAF** - A great hedge form of dwarf bottlebrush tree. Use as a small specimen tree in patio gardens or other tight spaces or use Slim to create a flower-filled hedge in Zones 8-11. Slim produces tons of large red flower spikes in spring and early summer. It's semi-dwarf & upright habit, abundance of large bottlebrush flowers, and good winter performance in milder climates distinguish Slim from others.



**Leaf:**

- Simple lanceolate leaves arranged in whorls along branches
- Young growth is light green; matures to a dark green with a smooth texture.



**Habit:**

- 10 ft H x 4 ft W; upright & narrow growth habit
- Quicker to finish than other dwarf Callistemon
- Zones 8-11; confidently evergreen 8b/9-11



**Apps:**

- Low Maintenance & Drought Tolerant
- Great for hedges; responds well to pruning
- Home Gardens
- Streetscapes & Commercial Landscapes



**Bloom:**

- Big, bold red bottlebrush flowers absolutely cover the plant in spring and early summer; a great sales feature in spring!

**Notables:**

- LIKES - Well drained soils; Full sun to light shade
- DISLIKES - Over watering and temps below 15° F

- Low maintenance flowering shrub, drought tolerant, frost tolerant, salt tolerant



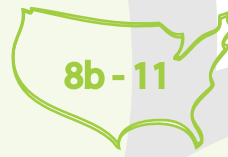
**CROP TIME:**

3-gal: 6-10 mos. from liners  
 5/7-gal: 12+ mos. from liners  
 15-gal: 18+ months  
 \*depending on inputs & climate



**SALES STRATEGY:**

Sell as a drought tolerant hedge shrub that has great flower appeal in spring and early summer. Great for retail!



**LANDSCAPE NICHE:**

Evergreen shrub/small tree that is a nice alternative to ficus, cypress, ligustrum, etc in milder climates. Low maintenance.



**CONTAINER APP:**

Can be used in very large planters like those in commercial settings and urban street-scaping.
