

# Westringia Mundi™



**Westringia fruticosa 'NFL25' PPAF** - A great groundcover form of coastal rosemary. Used as a specimen or in mass, Mundi is great for tough roadsides and residential gardens alike. Best suited to Zones 9-11 in arid climates although Mundi continues to show potential for low water gardens in humid regions. It's super short height and infrequent pruning requirement distinguish Mundi from other Westringia currently on the market.



**Leaf:**

- Small, rosemary-like leaves arranged in whorls along the branches
- Young growth is light gray-green; matures to a deep gray-green with a smooth texture.



**Habit:**

- 1.5 ft H x 5 ft W; decumbent growth habit
- Quick to finish & easily established in the garden
- Zones 9-11; confidently evergreen in 9b -11



**Apps:**

- Low Maintenance & Drought Tolerant
- Responds well to pruning
- Waterwise Home Gardens
- Streetscapes & Commercial Landscapes



**Bloom:**

- Snow-white, quarter-sized flowers appear in small clusters along the stems from late winter to summer and sporadically throughout the season. A definite sales feature in spring/summer

**Notables:**

- LIKES - Full sun; occasional watering & fertilizer
- DISLIKES - Over watering and temps below 20° F

**Sales Niche:**

- Low maintenance flowering shrub, drought tolerant, frost tolerant, salt tolerant



**CROP TIME:**

- 1-gal: 6-9 mos. from liners
- 2/3-gal: 12+ mos. from liners
- 5/7-gal: 18+ months
- \*depending on inputs & climate



**SALES STRATEGY:**

Sell as a drought & salt tolerant groundcover shrub with a nice flower display from early spring to summer. Good for retail!



**LANDSCAPE NICHE:**

Low-growing evergreen shrub that is a great low maintenance option for Western landscapes (evaluating potential for Southeastern US).



**CONTAINER APP:**

Can be used in very large planters like those in commercial settings and urban street-scaping. Will trail over pot!!



Mundi will remain relatively well-behaved without pruning; or prune ever 1-2 years for a formal look.
