



**Liriope muscari 'LIRF' PP20,622** - A great low maintenance lawn substitute, border plant or groundcover option for Zones 6-11. Isabella can be used in the same applications as Ophiopogon mondograss but is quicker to establish and is more tolerant of drought and full sun. Fine leaf texture, low & uniform height as well as good winter performance in temperate climates distinguish this selection from common Liriope spicata.



**Leaf:**

- Fine-bladed, grassy foliage that is emerald green in color.
- Foliage texture similar to mondograss



**Habit:**

- 6-10 in H x 12-18 in W; spreading groundcover
- Faster to establish & mature compared to mondo
- Zone 6-11

**Bloom:**

- Light pink spike inflorescence that sits slightly above foliage in summer; becomes more abundant with time.

- LIKES - Well drained soils; Full sun to heavy shade
- DISLIKES - Over watering and temps below 15° F

**CROP TIME:**

4-inch: 2-4 months from bibs  
 1-gal: 6-8 months from bibs  
 3-gal: 12+ months from bibs  
 \*depending on inputs & climate



**SALES STRATEGY:**

Landscape commodity crop sold almost year-round (in most regions) for its foliage. Sells in or out of flower.



**LANDSCAPE NICHE:**

Excellent groundcover or lawn substitute wherever liriope and mondograss are sold.



**CONTAINER APP:**

Can be used in planters and mixed containers with some additional care, but not ideal due to it's spreading habit.
